November 10 to 14, 2010

Wednesday, November 10th

- Depart Oklahoma City mid-day
- Board the Sand Dollar live-aboard boat Wednesday evening
- San Dollar departs for San Clemente Island about mid-night

Thursday and Friday, November 11th and 12th

- Dive deck open for diving about 8:00 AM Thursday morning off San Clemente Island.
- Diving available all day and all night.

Saturday, November 13th

- Diving off Catalina Island
- Final dive, about 3:00 PM
- Disembark Sand Dollar about 6:00 PM.
- Check in to local hotel for the night.

Sunday, November 14th

- Depart Los Angeles for Oklahoma City
- Arrive Oklahoma City mid-afternoon

Includes**

- Round trip air fare from Oklahoma City to Los Angeles (LAX)
 - If providing own air, deduct \$450.00 from trip price
- Ground transportation from Los Angeles airport to boarding pier
- Unlimited diving on the live-aboard charter boat the Sand Dollar
- All meals on the Sand Dollar (“6 meals per day...good food”)
- Lodging on mainland Saturday night, double occupancy
- Tanks and weights. Nitrox extra charge, \$10/dive

Does Not
Include**

- Fishing license for those who choose to take lobster.
 - Estimated cost \$45 (to be confirmed).
- Catch bag and equipment to catch lobster
- Tips for the boat crew

Trip features

- Three days of unlimited diving. Dive deck will be open all night
 - Dive San Clemente and Catalina Islands
- Lobster season. Divers may take lobster in accord with local fishing regulations
- Instruction on how to find and take lobster (by crew of the Sand Dollar)
- Diving the kelp forest
- Sea lions and other California sea marine life
- Shore excursion on Catalina Island.

Please be aware this is a nice, well maintained live-aboard boat but it is not a luxury cruise liner. It is a live-aboard dive boat for serious divers, from beginners to the very experienced. There will be at least two Pirates Cove Scuba staff on the boat. The boat has been recommended to us by a friend who has been on the boat. However, if you don't like camping you may not like the quarters. There are, of course, private sleeping quarters and showers.
